

## Exhibition

The Waverley Patchworkers Quilt Show is held every second year. This is an exhibition of members' work and promotes quilting to the general community. In addition to the quilts on show, a variety of patchwork and quilting techniques are demonstrated and a 'Shoppers Mall' is provided by local quilt shops.

## Waverley Patchworkers Activities

### Monthly Meetings

The monthly meetings occur on the fourth Monday of the month (January to November) at Waverley Community Centre, Miller Crescent, Mount Waverley (opposite the Mount Waverley station), Melway 61 E12. These feature guest speakers, 'Show and Tell' of members' work, a trading table and the opportunity to borrow from the comprehensive library.

Doors open at 7.30pm for an 8.00pm start. Visitors are welcome to attend and after a few visits you will be encouraged to join. The entry fee is \$3 and bring your own mug for a cuppa.

### Workshops

Instruction in a variety of patchwork and quilting techniques is offered throughout the year, as one or two day workshops at a local venue. Local and interstate tutors are engaged to share their knowledge and expertise.

### June Lyons Class

Every second year, Waverley Patchworkers sponsors two days of workshops for members with a tutor of note. Admission to this class is at a reduced cost and by ballot.

### Friendship Groups

These are small groups of members sharing skills and knowledge on an informal basis. Help can be obtained at the monthly meeting on setting up a Friendship Group.
